2. Four Seasons Astir Palace Hotel Athens

Recently revamped, the historic Astir Palace (frequent haunt of Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, Charlton Heston, Frank Sinatra and Joan Collins), has upped the ante for seaside glitz here. Perched on a peninsula directly on the Aegean Sea, the 303-room hotel has seven restaurants and bars, private beaches equipped with snorkeling, wind surfing and Jet Skis, a variety of pools, boat outings to archaeological sites on nearby islands (Aegina, Hydra, Poros) and sunset sailing nightly.





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

Palace Hotel Athens, a chef-led "first taste" tour walks and talks you through the inner workings of a hotel restaurant, as culinary advice is shared behind-the-scenes—before the dining room opens to other patrons. Pelagos restaurant (above), deftly managed by executive chef Bertrand Valegeas, serves sophisticated Greek seafood, such as lavraki (sea bass) carpaccio, chtapodi (octopus) and whole grilled fish deboned tableside. Perched on the pine-dressed peninsula of the swanky Athens Riviera, dotted with glamorous yachts, Astir Palace is a half-hour drive to the city center. Once frequented by Jackie Kennedy, Aristotle Onassis and The Beatles. the Astir Palace, sprawling across a pine-scented peninsula on the Athens Riviera, has reopened as the Four Seasons' first property in Greece. It's actually two hotels (and 61 bungalows), the retro-chic Arion and boho resort-y Nafsika, where Athenians come to see and be seen by the olive tree-lined, sea-facing pool. Thirty minutes from the city centre, it's easy to pop up to the Acropolis, but it's also a serene retreat from the city's bustle. There are three private beaches, muscle-melting massages in the marble and lightfilled spa, and four restaurants (best of all, Pelagos, serving catch of the day with lemon and olive oil). Rooms are stylish and contemporary with traditional Greek touches like evil eyes and a tipple of mastika left at turn-down. Rooms at Nafsika have jaw-dropping views over the Aegean and the yachts that slide in for a taste of the Astir Palace life. Elegant Resorts (elegantresorts.co.uk) offers seven nights from £1,450, including flights and transfers.

CHĂTEAU SAINT-MARTIN Vence, France

Built on 12th-century castle ruins, the steeply perched Château Saint-Martin was transformed into a hotel and spa by its owners between the Thirties and Sixties. Views from the south-facing windows are gasp-outloud stunning: the walled village of Vence in the foreground and the Cap d'Antibes and coast beyond. An intimate restaurant, spacious patio bar and all the guest rooms sit on this side, bathed in sunshine. Above the property looms the steep rock wall of Baou des Blancs, tempting guests

down on the panoramic sweep of this gorgeous building, surrounded by olive and lemon trees, and its six butler-serviced villas. By arrangement, the chef can lead picnic parties up the Baou. It's a timeless place, but there are overt nods to now. A brightly coloured mural by artist Erick Ifergan envelops the highceilinged room off the lobby that used to be the chapel. The modern spa offers a signature treatment based on the oil extracted from the orange-pink Tango roses cultivated in the garden. And check out the helipad: there for guests to make the eight-minute flight to Monaco during grand prix weekend. Double, from £300 (oetkercollection.com).

TREMEZZO

Lake Como, Italy Greta Garbo said the Tremezzo was one of her favourite hotels in the world, her 'sunny, happy place'. In her spirit, fling open the bedroom shutters of Suite Greta, look out over the ravishing setting of Lake Como and wholeheartedly embrace the indulgence. To sit on the terrace and sip a glass of chilled Franciacorta while drinking in those views is to be in hotel heaven. With its gilded. draped and upholstered grandeur, and hundreds of sparkling windows, this is one of Lake Como's old-school greats. The star swimming pool floats on the lake, but another glorious pool lies tucked away in the gardens, surrounded by towering palms and banana plants, a heavenly space ornamented with statuary and vines, where a great stone staircase cascades down to the water's edge. The spa housed in the 18th-century Villa Emilia has impressive treatments; equally restorative is time spent taking in the views from the relaxation area. Destinations Tatler's Travel Editor Is Dreaming Of: The Athenian Riviera

For a cultural and coastal escape, nowhere compares to Athens, especially holed up at Four Seasons Astir Palace, a temple of chic with an impressive holistic spa that will take near Herculean resolve to leave...













So much history is packed into Athens's streets and along its shores. After all, this is the birthplace of western civilisation and democracy. It's the home of Zeus and Socrates, a city with winding cracked stone alleyways, walls overgrown with jasmine creepers and gardens abundant with bitter orange

Little wonder that when Lord Byron (the ultimate Hellenophile) drew up to the shores in 1809, he was so seduced by the place - and by the daughter of the British Consul - that he wrote in the Maid of Athens he had seen nothing finer.

Today, the combination of its historic splendour and vibrant arts and cultural scene is irresistible. Take a stroll to the antiques market in the neighbourhood of Monastiraki, where 70s socialist buildings jostle against ancient vine draped squares, where the intoxicating smell of honeysuckle, leather and dust fills the air. Here, seek out the Tsantilis Gallery, an antique store that houses the most impressive collection of 18th century Orientalist art and Philhellenic treasures from fabulous uras to Napoleonic chandeliers. Step into Cycladic civilisation at the Cyclades Art Museum for an incredible collection of ancient sculptures and ceramics and figurines. Watch arthouse classics at Cine Paris, possibly the world's most impressive open-air cinema next door to the Acropolis. Or just revel on the rooftop of the incomparable Grand Bretagne and eat breakfast overlooking the Plaka, watching the changing of the guards. Come nightfall, imbibe the old school magic of this institution, with one of the Barman Sypros's signature martinis and soak up the views of the uplit Parthenon and Tomb of the Unknown Solider.

But the city's best kept secret lies half an hour from the centre, on the cypressand cactus-studded coast of Vouliagmeni, famed for its healing thermal waters. It is also home to the glamorous stretch of Astir Beach with its glorious black and white striped umbrellas and daybeds, not to mention its very own marina, yacht club and 6th-century BC ruins, the Temple of Apollo Zoster. The area is known affectionately as the Athenian Riviera and has been marinated in pure unadulterated jet set glamour since its Sixties prime. At the centre of it all is the Astir Palace hotel, the place where Christina Onassis learnt to water ski, Brigitte Bardot hired a doppelganger so she could hangout poolside uninterrupted and Rudolf Nureyev drifted along the boardwalk to his favorite bungalow...

Today, high-octane glamour is still a given. The name conjures up sun, Valentino and bure feet. Here there are no cute fishing boats or tanned seamen mending nets - just elegant yachts, sleekly bobbing in the marina before the party people descend on the new Four Seasons Astir Palace jetty.



And what waves the legendary Four Seasons hotel has created since it relaunched, following a £230 million facelift. Previously majority-owned by the National Bank of Greece, the hotel and beach club was sold in 2016 as part of the drive to reduce national debt. The new owner, Jermyn Street (an investment group backed by Abu Dhabi, Kuwait and the Turkish Dogus group) brought in the Four Seasons to manage the hotel - creating 650 jobs for the local Greek economy in the process - and it has truly regained its title as the ultimate beachside pleasure dome.

The Martin Brudnizki-designed seafood restaurant, Pelagos, is like the Scott's of Athens, and serves an impressive lobster spaghetti and the most refined grilled calamari with fava bean puree, all paired with delicious Greek wines, It's fabulously inviting here, with a sweeping terrace and plenty of polished marble, driftwood sculptures and exposed stone interiors employed by one of the project's starchitects, K-studio, which perfectly conjures up the simplicity and sophistication that is the essence of Greek style

The high jinks and excess start at daybreak, where every manner of fun and games is on tap: a Greek Breakfast, of the iced coffee and cigarette variety is most welcome - including cigars, should you prefer. Then, of course, there is the bikini-friendly and gluten-free spread of dreams - cue endless varieties of yoghurt and artisan honeys, eggs cooked every which way. It's served at the various terraced restaurants overlooking the royal blue and navy Aegean lapping below.



There's also the famous watersports school to explore, with boatmen on hand and outboard motors at the ready. Messing about on the water is certainly one of the vivid pleasures of staying here, but this is also a place where you can easily escape the exuberant beach-club vibe to enjoy a more sedate existence in the glorious spa, where you can take part in rituals inspired by the teachings of Hipprocates, alongside more esoteric treatments of reiki and pelma reflexology.

And for those looking to drink in the area's antiquity of classical sites, there could be no dreamier spot than the Temple of Poseidon in nearby Cape Sounion. It's famed as having the best sunsets in all of Athens, and the golden light here will seduce you, especially on a boat trip on an elegant wooden schooner arranged by the Four Seasons. They also offer party-time and seafaring adventure with such verve, with their crew on hand to prepare sundowners served with platters of just freshly caught Dorade ceviche and sashimi that morph into starlit seafood burbecues.

As the sun descends over the southern tip of the Attica Peninsula with its stunning coves and deserted beaches, it bathes the temple and its Doric columns that punctuate this craggy promenade in an otherworldly stillness.

Lord Byron was so moved by the area's beauty that he carved his name into the base of one of the columns. He wrote, in his 1881 poem, On The Isles of Greece:

'Place me on Sunium's marbled steep,

Where nothing, save the waves and I,

May hear our mutual murmurs sweep....'

Regardless of the fact that this newly-opened Four Seasons is just 30-minutes away from the historic city centre, you'd be forgiven for passing on a tourist visit to the Acropolis in favour of another day spent in the comfort of this sprawling hotel, so sprawling (75 acres in fact) that golf buggies are on hand to swiftly transport guests from room to pool, or to one of its three pristine private beaches, or, perhaps, to one its eight restaurants (offering everything from relaxed beach bar bites to traditional Greek food and Mediterranean menus). Situated on a vast peninsula along Athens Riviera the views are as good looking as the interiors.



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

FOUR SEASONS ASTIR PALACE Athens Riviera, Greece

The Four Seasons Astir Palace boldly strides 75 acres of the most expensive strip of Athenian real estate — the coastal land that stretches between the Parthenon in the historic center and the archaeological site of Sounion on the tip of the Attic peninsula. This year sees the much-lauded relaunch of the city's 1960s landmark. Once the cherished beach club and watering hole of Onassis, Bardot and Sinatra, its old-school allure was eventually eclipsed by the more bohemian charms of the Greek islands, when the jet set migrated elsewhere. But the Athenian Riviera's Astir Palace enjoyed a huge revival this summer, after the massive restoration project and the injection of Four Seasons style, polish and service, without losing a unique sense of heritage vibe and sleek Greek modernist aesthetic. In October, the crowds have dissipated and the sun hangs lower on the horizon, but no less golden through the long Mediterranean summer that bumps up to November. With six restaurants, three private coves, three pools (one with a floating olive grove), water sports, a massive spa, crèches and a kids' club, it will make a spontaneous European weekend in fall feel like a long vacation.

If you're starting your Sunday working through your diary and wondering what to do next weekend, I already have it sorted fo you — it goes like this. First, some good news: the weekend is going to start on a Thursday, at a boarding gate flashing "Last call for Athens". From there you're going to board an Aegean, Lufthansa or Swiss flight and in less than three hours (I know, know, you may not live in the heart of Europe but just play along) you'll be walking off an Airbus, hopefully skipping the pop-up coronavirus testing bays and looking for a driver with a Four Seasons sign. Twenty-five minutes later a very tall Austrian named Hannes will be greeting you and showing you to a funked-up 1960s bungalow and you'll be at the start of the perfect, late-summer Med long weekender. I know all of this because, at long last, I'm taking what resembles a proper summer holiday — and all the better that it's at the start of Q4.

Things got off to the best possible start on my arrival in Athens as the second that I stepped off the plane a Monocle reader bound for Bavaria wished me a good morning and a good stay in Greece. As he'd read last week's column he enthusiastically passed on some culinary and cultural tips but what were the chances that he'd be at the very same Schengen gate for his departure and my arrival? No matter, it proved to be a tone-setter for what was to come.

At long last, I'm taking what resembles a proper summer holiday – and all the better that it's at the start of Q4.

Also, what were the chances that the former GM of the Park Hyatt Tokyo (the hotel where I've clocked the most nights) would now be running the show at the Four Seasons Athens property? As much as we credit good design, sound architecture and star chefs for creating and building buzz for a property, nothing beats a capable GM to ensure a good stay and maintain standards. Working with an already outstanding piece of real estate also helps.

Friends who stayed at the Astir Palace before the Greek government sold it and the Four Seasons took over the management speak of a faded, somewhat forgotten architectural gem. The good news is that the good bones remain intact, the F&B offering has had a serious upgrade and the designers didn't go too crazy trying to please Gulfies, Russians or others in search of added gloss and unnecessary sparkle. While I've only been here a few hours, I can already recommend it as it's perhaps the best resort-hotel on the Med that also boasts a capital city on its doorstep and an airport less than 30 minutes away. For the moment, Greece is trying its best to stay on top of infection rates and keep parts of its tourism industry open. Long may this continue. The mayor of Athens promised Monocle that summer is going to run for another full month, so you've got a couple of weekends left to juggle the diary, monitor your tan lines and plan for a weekend of long morning swims in the Med, late afternoons scented with warm cypress and Santorini whites to drink.
